Requirements for this scholarship include the following:

Family Information: Father/Mother

- 1. An application must be completed and returned to H&H Federal Credit Union PO Box 1187, Stinnett, TX 79083 by March 24, 2023.
- 2. Additionally, applicants must submit the following:
 - A brief description of career goals. If the career goal is in education, explain which area(s) are of interest and why.
 - Two letters of recommendation that are sealed in an envelope and included with this application. The first letter must come from a citizen in the community, a minister, an employer, or an adult advisor. The second recommendation letter must come from a teacher or educator.
- 3. Applicant must be a member of H&H Federal Credit Union or Education Credit Union. The <u>student</u> must have a savings account in their name on or before March 24, 2023. Call 806-878-2452 for more information.
- 4. Applicant must be a graduating senior from one of the high schools in these locations: Borger, Stinnett, Fritch, Gruver, Spearman, Panhandle, Dumas, Sunray, Groom, White Deer. One scholarship can be awarded to one individual from each of these eligible locations.
- 5. An overall high school grade point average of 3.0 is required; therefore, a copy of the applicant's overall high school transcript must accompany the application when it is returned.
- 6. The applicant must take a minimum of twelve accredited college hours each semester. At the end of the fall semester, a transcript must be submitted in order to receive funds in the spring semester. Awardee must maintain a 2.5 grade point average in college in order to remain eligible for scholarship funds.

Scholarship applications will be extended only upon request and will be judged by Education Credit Union Foundation's Scholarship Committee. If H&H management cannot make a presentation to the recipient at their school, recipient should be willing to come to the offices of H&H Federal Credit Union for the scholarship presentation and photo so that information can be released to local news media.
